

Prince of Songkla University Announcement New International Student Preparation Procedures for Academic Year 2017

Students who have been accepted to PSU need to report and register to be considered a PSU student, otherwise their student status will not be considered complete. In case the student cannot report in time, a written notification to the university is needed within seven days from the due date of self-report, otherwise it will be considered a withdrawal from the current semester. Students who do not report within 30 days from the due date will not be eligible to be a student of PSU. All eligible students must go through the procedures listed below:

1. Document preparation and self-report information

- 1.1 Check the Student ID on the website: http://www.reg.psu.ac.th
- 1.2 Provide information in the student database at

http://www.psu1-2.psu.ac.th/PSU1-2/ and upload the following document files through the system (SE-DOC) at http://regfile.psu.ac.th/student:

• Photo of student (undergraduates in student uniform, graduate students in black, gray or navy blue suit), without hat or glasses. Veil is allowed; it should be white for undergraduate students, while for graduate students it should be white or identical to the suit's color.

- Passport main page
- A certified, complete academic transcript

After providing data in the database and uploading the required documents, the report will be issued within 2 days.

1.3 Pay tuition fees through our bill payment system between July 24 - August 2, 2017 (go to http://sis.psu.ac.th, print out the invoice to pay at Siam Commercial Bank Public Company Limited, Bangkok Bank Public Company Limited, or Krung Thai Bank Public Company Limited).

Note: paid tuition fees will NOT be refunded in any case, even after withdrawal. Undergraduate students already confirmed to be PSU students can pay the remaining tuition fee or pay the amount determined by their faculty.

- 2.2 Self-report processing
- 2.2.1 Submit the following self-report documents:
 - Self-report Form (1.2)
 - A certified, complete academic transcript
- 2.2.2 Confirm self-report via the system
- 2.2.3 Receive student ID card

The university requires all new students to have a student iD card (PSU ATM ID CARD) to use on-campus services such as the library and computer center. It can also be used as an ATM card at Siam Commercial Bank Public Company Limited (SCB). The requirements are detailed below:

- A copy of passport main page
- Annual fee of 100 baht (first payment due when opening

an account at the bank)

The course registration system contains compulsory course details, listed in the Handbook for Undergraduate Students Year 2017 (English course students can check the registration following the university's announcement regarding the registration for the foundation English course for PSU Hat Yai Campus, at http://reg.psu.ac.th/reg/notificatguidline/news1-4-1-50.pdf. Students must confirm the course registration; otherwise it will be considered incomplete, resulting in ineligibility to attend classes.
