

Schedule, Procedures, and Recommendations
For Receiving Degrees in the 2022 and 2023 Academic Years
from Prince of Songkla University As of August 22, 2024

To ensure a smooth commencement ceremony for the 2022 and 2023 academic years of Prince of Songkla University from September 18 to 21, 2024, the Subcommittee on Ceremonies provides the following schedule, procedures, and recommendations for graduates of all degree levels:

1. Reporting and Rehearsals for the Commencement Ceremony

This year's rehearsals will be divided by campus, especially for undergraduate graduates, as follows:

The date, time, and location of reporting and rehearsals for the Phuket, Surat Thani, Trang, and Pattani campuses will be determined by the respective campus subcommittees. Reporting and rehearsals at the Hat Yai campus will be determined by the central ceremony subcommittee (see additional documents 4 for the schedule).

2. Guidelines for Major Rehearsal Day

As major rehearsals are held separately, each campus will provide specific information on the date, time, and location in additional documents. The general guidelines are as follows:

2.1 Attire: Wear the academic gown as on the ceremony day.

2.2 Do not bring any items or communication devices into the rehearsal room, except for an ID card, car keys, and room keys, Please keep the items with you in a manner that does not interfere with your rehearsal, such as storing them in your shirt pocket, pants pocket, or skirt pocket.

2.3 Follow the rehearsal procedures for receiving the degree and any additional guidelines that may be announced later.

2.4 Graduates who miss the major rehearsal will be disqualified from attending the commencement Ceremony. Graduates who must miss the major rehearsal should submit a written request to the university before August 31, 2024, and must receive approval. (Please contact the Education and Innovative Learning Academy for document submission.)

2.5 Graduates must wear a face mask throughout the rehearsal, except when permitted by the subcommittee.

3. Procedures on the Commencement Ceremony Day

3.1 Date and Time: Wednesday, September 18 to Saturday, September 21, 2024
(see schedule in Table 1).

3.2 Venue: 60th Anniversary of His Majesty the King's Accession to the Throne
International Convention Center, Prince of Songkla University.

3.3 Procedures for Graduates:

3.3.1 Attire: Wear the academic gown as specified (**see Section 5**).

3.3.2 Do not bring any items or communication devices into the ceremony hall, except for an ID card and a banknote not exceeding 100 baht, kept securely in your pocket. Confiscated prohibited items will not be returned.

3.3.3 Follow the steps (**Table 2**) and procedures for receiving the degree as specified (Section 6) and any additional guidelines that may be announced later.

3.3.4 Graduates arriving late will be disqualified from attending the Commencement Ceremony Day.

3.3.5 Graduates must wear a face mask as provided by the subcommittee at all times during the ceremony.

4. COVID-19 Screening Procedures

Graduates testing positive in either test will not be allowed to participate in rehearsals or the ceremony but may request to receive their degree with the graduates of the 2024 academic year. Additionally, body temperature checks will be conducted before entering the ceremony hall. Graduates with a temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius will undergo further screening. 5. Graduate Attire

5.1 Attire and Academic Gown:

5.1.1 **Male graduates**: Wear black **long trousers**, modest and suitable for the ceremony, and a Raj pattern collar shirt with the faculty/college/program insignia.

5.1.2 **Female graduates**: Wear the student uniform, which includes **a black skirt that covers the knees but not longer than the ankles**, and a white short-sleeved shirt with university buttons and a properly fastened collar. For long-sleeved shirts as part of

the female Muslim student uniform, replace the metal cuff buttons with white fabric or plastic buttons, and wear a black hijab before putting on the cap.

5.1.3 Graduates who are government officials

- **Civil servants:** Wear the full-dress white uniform, with female graduates wearing the academic cap and male graduates holding the academic cap with the left hand.

- **Police and military officers:** Please wear the uniform as specified by your respective agency. If gloves, sabers, and cords are required, please bring them along. Female graduates who are required to bow according to regulations should not wear a cap. A rehearsal will be arranged for the graduates to practice holding the saber while receiving the degree at an appropriate time.

5.1.4 Wear the academic gown over the uniform in Sections 5.1.1–5.1.3 :

- **5.1.4.1** Drape the hood with the faculty/field color.

- **5.1.4.2** Pin the insignia at the center of the right-hand side sash.

- **5.1.4.3 Male graduates:** Hold the cap with the left hand at all times during the ceremony, keeping the brim parallel to the ground and the cap's angle in the crook of the arm. Wear the cap after returning to your seat, **with the tassel on the left side.**

- **5.1.4.4 Female graduates:** Wear the cap at all times during the **ceremony with the tassel on the right side.** After returning to your seat, move the tassel to the left.

- **5.1.4.5** After the graduates recite the oath, the leader will signal to move the tassel to the right simultaneously, symbolizing full graduate status.

5.2 Stockings, Socks, and Shoes:

5.2.1 Male graduates: Wear black long socks and black leather shoes, plain with no metal parts or decorations.

5.2.2 Female graduates: Wear plain flesh-colored full stockings and black court shoes, fully enclosed, plain with no decorations or patterns. Sandals and high-heeled shoes are prohibited.

5.3 Hair:

5.3.1 Male graduates: Keep hair and color modest and suitable for the ceremony. If necessary, trim mustaches and beards neatly.

5.3.2 Female graduates: Keep hair and color modest and suitable for the ceremony and wear the cap with the brim parallel to the ground. No hair accessories are allowed.

5.4 Jewelry: No body adornments, including necklaces, rings, watches, wristbands, earrings, brooches, or flower pins on the gown. No flower garlands on the head. Sunglasses are not allowed (prescription glasses are allowed). **Refrain from using perfumes.**

5.5 Nails: Graduates must trim their nails short, not apply nail polish, or decorate their nails.

5.6 The determination of the appropriateness and correctness of the graduates' attire is at the discretion of the Chairperson of the Ceremony Subcommittee or their designated representative. If any inappropriate attire or unreasonable issues are found and not rectified, the ceremony may be suspended.

6. Procedures for Receiving the Degree

6.1 Walking

- 6.1.1 When marching up to the stage, graduates should maintain appropriate spacing between each other and avoid deviating from the line.

- 6.1.2 When you see the marked points on the stage, step on each point and proceed with the steps as specified in 6.5.2.

- 6.1.3 When walking down from the stage, graduates should maintain appropriate spacing between each other until they reach their seats.

6.2 Standing Up, Sitting Down, and Marching in Line

- 6.2.1 When standing up to receive the degree, graduates should follow the signal from the line coordinator. **Stand up together softly**, making minimal noise, pay respect in unison, turn left, and march out of the seat.

- 6.2.2 After receiving the degree and descending from the stage, walk back to your original seat, pay respect, and sit down. Place the degree on your lap.

6.3 Paying Respect

- **6.3.1 Male graduates** should stand straight, with feet together, hands at the sides, and bow the head slightly.

- **6.3.2 Female graduates** should step the left foot back slightly to the right, bend the knees gracefully, stand straight, and bow the head slightly. For quickness, after stepping the left foot and bending, step the left foot out first followed by the right foot towards the marked point and bring the left foot back in line - following the rhythm: left, right, together.

Female graduates in civil servant uniforms should perform the traditional "Thaworn Sai Bua" respect, while those in military or police uniforms should follow their respective regulations.

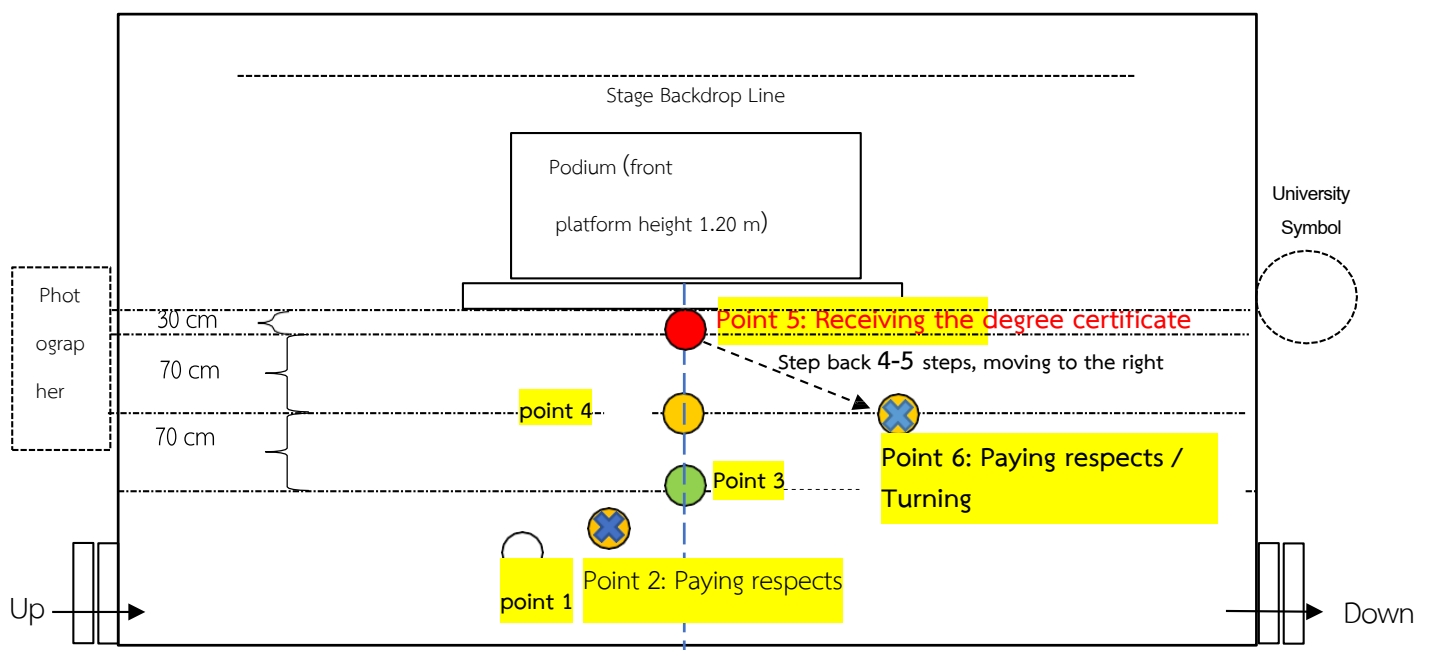
- 6.3.3 Respect should be paid at two points on the stage as indicated in the layout.

6.4 Receiving and Holding the Degree

Raise the right hand, palm perpendicular to the degree (fingers together and not tense), slightly lift the wrist before sliding the palm to grasp the degree. Use the thumb to hold the top of the degree, gently pull it out and hold it against the chest while stepping back.

6.5 Receiving the Degree

Stage layout and positions for receiving the degree certificate
for the academic year 2022 and 2023



- 6.5.1 The rate for receiving degrees is set at approximately 38-40 graduates per minute.

- 6.5.2 Refer to the stage diagram: Graduates should walk onto the stage in a continuous line, maintaining an appropriate distance. There is no need to step in rhythm, **but when you see the marked spot on the stage**, step on it and continue moving in the sequence: left, right, left, from **point 1 to point 6** as follows:

Female graduates who need to perform the "Sāi Būa" (slight bow) (The bow does not need to be deep, and there is no need to clasp your hands):

- From point 1, step left, right, and then slightly bow by bending the left knee at point 2 (count: left, right, bow). Then, continue stepping with the left foot to point 3 in the rhythm of left, right, together.

- From point 3, step left, right, together to point 4 without pausing.

- From point 4 to point 5, step left, right, and as you bring your left foot together, raise your hand to receive the degree certificate (count: left, right, together + raise the right hand to receive). Roll your hand to hold the certificate close to your chest, then step back together toward your right. Take about 4 to 5 steps back, perform a slight bow at point 6, and turn right to walk off the stage while holding the degree certificate close to your chest. Male graduates or graduates who need to bow (slight bow of the head, not too deep, for a quick movement):

- From point 1, step left, right, together, and bow at point 2 (count: left, right, together). Then, continue stepping with the left foot to point 3 in the rhythm of left, right, together.

- From point 3, step left, right, together to point 4 without pausing.

- From point 4 to point 5, step left, right, and as you bring your feet together, raise your hand to receive the degree certificate (count: left, right, together + raise the right hand to receive). Roll your hand to hold the certificate close to your chest, then step back together toward your right. Take about 4 to 5 steps back, bow at **point 6**, and turn right to walk off the stage while holding the degree certificate close to your chest.

6.5.3 **Point 5** is the point where you receive the degree certificate. Graduates should step forward until they are almost touching the platform. Slightly bend your arm when raising it to receive the degree certificate to avoid touching the platform.

6.5.4 The first graduate in each group should lead the line along the marked points without stepping in rhythm. They should wait at **point 4**, and when their name is called, they should step forward to receive the degree certificate at point 5.

6.5.6 The first graduate of each program following another program should, after bowing at point 2, move to stand by at **point 4**. When their name is called, they should step forward to receive the degree certificate at **point 5**.

Important Notes

1. For efficiency and a neat appearance, all graduates are requested to move with strength and agility.
 2. When extending your hand to receive the degree certificate, graduates should time their movement carefully without pausing or touching the platform. There is no need to fully extend your arm, but be cautious of any swinging motion that could cause the certificate to fall from the royal hand.

The lineup order and procedures for entering the seats are the same as the rehearsal day.

Table 2

Steps for Receiving the Degree

Steps for Receiving the Degree
1. Graduates line up according to their names and verify the list (refer to the schedule in Table 1 and the layout).
2. March into the convention hall: 2.1 Verify the list again by clearly stating your full name at the verification point. 2.2 Pass through the weapon and prohibited items check, temperature screening, hand sanitizing station, and mask change (this step is only for the degree conferral day). In case the weapon detector sounds or the body temperature exceeds the limit, staff will separate the graduate for further inspection or body search. The next graduate in line should hold a sign indicating one seat gap. Note: D During list verification, staff may need to touch or search graduates (female staff for female graduates).
3. Graduates proceed to their designated seats in the convention hall and conference hall. Graduates must sit in their assigned seats only and are not allowed to change seats on their own.

4. Remain seated while waiting for the royal arrival. Permission to use the restroom will be given periodically, or if there is a sudden illness, notify the subcommittee in the ceremony area.
5. March up to the stage to receive the degree according to the order.
6. March back to the seat and sit quietly with the degree placed on the lap. Male graduates wear their caps, and female graduates move the tassel to the left.
7. When the representative of the graduates steps out after the last graduate receives the degree, all graduates should stand up, recite the pledge following the representative, and move the tassel when instructed by the representative.
8. The ceremony ends, but graduates must remain seated until the royal departure.

- Male graduate** Wear black dress pants and black leather, closed-toe shoes without metal embellishments. It is recommended to use the pair of shoes prepared for the ceremony, and ensure to shave your beard and mustache neatly.
- Graduates must fill out their employment status information on the website <https://job.psu.ac.th> to use as documentation for reporting and receiving their academic badge.

- Graduates are prohibited from wearing any kind of jewelry on both the combined rehearsal day and the main rehearsal day
- No bags or personal items are allowed on the actual graduation day (no items will be accepted for storage)

Guidelines for Graduates

During the rehearsal, graduates should dress in regulation student uniforms as follows

- **Female graduates** should wear a black skirt that reaches the knee but is not longer than the ankle. Shoes should be simple black pumps without metal embellishments or bows, with heels no higher than 2 inches and not overly pointed. It is advisable to use the pumps prepared for the ceremony day and to wear plain, nude-colored tights.
- **Male graduates** should wear black dress trousers and black leather dress shoes that are simple and free of metal decorations. It is advisable to use the dress shoes prepared for the ceremony day and ensure that facial hair is neatly shaved.

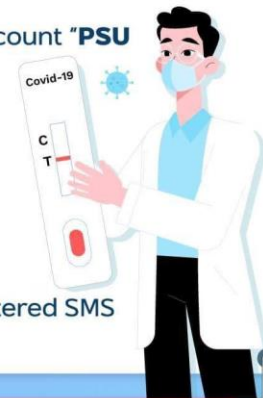

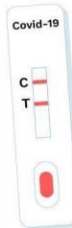
