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Prince of Songkla University Announcement

Subject: Guidelines for course credit comparison with educational institutions in the
European Union

Prince of Songkla University has a memorandum of understanding on academic cooperation under the Erasmus+ program with a group of higher educational institutions (HEIs) in the European Union (EU), fostering student exchange at both undergraduate and graduate levels. Eligible students may enroll at the participating institutions for a period of one semester to one academic year, using the allocated scholarships at the aforementioned institutions. In addition, Prince of Songkla University's policy allows the enrollment of foreign students with appropriate credit transfer back to the parent institution.

Since course credit allocation differs widely between EU and Thai HEIs, special steps must be taken to ensure that course credit comparison between Prince of Songkla University and EU HEIs is accurate and consistent through all faculties and organizations. Therefore, the university has established the following guidelines:

1. For EU HEI students enrolling at Prince of Songkla University, faculties/units should multiply the number of credits earned in each course by 1.67 (based on US and EU credit transfer guidelines).
2. For PSU students registering for courses at an EU HEI, consideration of credit fees is at the discretion of the faculty the student is affiliated with.
3. If an exchange student from an EU HEI under the Erasmus Mundus program chooses to register for courses of faculties that are not part of the Erasmus agreement, the faculties that are parties to the contract allocate credits to the faculties that provide the selected courses.
